	<p><b>Always do your best, be fair and have fun</b> This is an activity you have chosen to do so make the most of it and try to do your best. Be fair to yourself and others in the group and most of all have fun!</p>
	<p><b>Respect all property belonging to you. Respect other people and the club you take part in.</b> When you use any equipment at your activity, please make sure you use it carefully. If any equipment is broken, please tell the adult who is in charge of the activity. Put all equipment away in the correct place at the end of the activity.</p>
	<p><b>Bullying is totally unacceptable</b> Everyone who is at the activity deserves to feel safe and happy while they are there. Nobody likes a bully, so try to be friendly to those in your group.</p>
	<p><b>Respect others in the group</b> Everyone who is at the activity deserves to have an opinion. Everyone should be able to speak how they feel without fear of being laughed at. Please don't be rude</p>
	<p><b>Listen carefully to instructions</b> You should listen carefully to instructions and stay quiet whilst the adult who is in charge of the activity is speaking, otherwise you won't know what to do and this will spoil the activity for you and others in your group.</p>
	<p><b>Medicines</b> It is your responsibility to bring your medicines to the after school club and put them in the medicine box provided</p>
