The course will run every Wednesday evening from 6pm – 9pm at The Maplewood Centre, Marley Potts, Sunderland SR5 5AX Learners will also need access to a volunteer/work placement.

The qualification is designed for people who are already working in a youth work environment (public, voluntary or private sector, paid or unpaid) in an assisting or supportive role and who are supervised.

Recruitment evenings will be held on Wednesday 14th December 2016 and 4th January 2017 at the Maplewood Centre from 6pm – 9pm.
