Year One Remember...

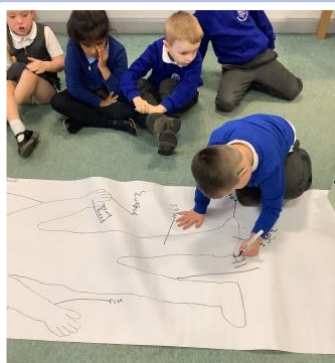
