In science we have been learning about sound. We have looked at how sounds are made, how sounds travel through solids, liquids and gases, how the ear works and what the pitch of a sound is. To demonstrate our understanding of sound we had a go at making our own pan flutes using straws and elastic bands. We even tried to play "three blind mice" using the flutes although admittedly it was a little difficult!
