Plants: We have really enjoyed learning about plants, identifying and labelling their different parts, and discovering how they grow from tiny seeds into fully grown plants. We planted our own seeds and carefully looked after them, watching them grow into cress and sunflowers. We also loved exploring different plants outdoors and observing the variety of beautiful colours around us. To finish our learning, we created our own colourful flowers using spinners and crayons.



Minibeasts: The children had lots of fun learning about minibeasts during our outdoor learning session. Using magnifying glasses, they went on a minibeast hunt around the school grounds to see what they could find. They discovered worms, woodlice, spiders, and beetles hiding in the grass and under leaves. The children carefully collected some worms and worked together to make a wormery using soil, sand, and leaves. The children enjoyed exploring nature and learning about how worms help the soil.



ArtVenturers: We had a wonderful visit to Artventurers, where the children explored a range of exciting sensory art activities. They experimented with both large and small-scale creative tasks using a variety of tools, textures, and materials. The session encouraged creativity, communication, and confidence in a fun, hands-on environment, and everyone thoroughly enjoyed the experience.
