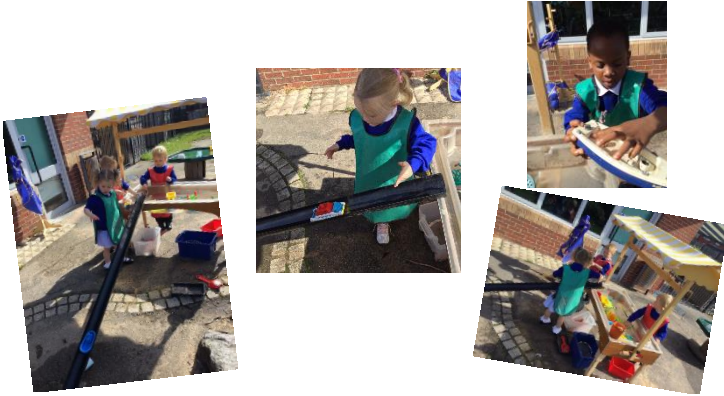




Nursery Newsletter Summer 2
